The NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND partnership came together with the shared desire to look at ways of promoting among policymakers, schools and NGOs in Europe the key principles and good practice measures that have made the UK Study Support system effective by designing a training pack that will ultimately benefit young people at schools across Europe.

The main product of NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND partnership is the training kit. The aim of this training kit is to provide knowledge, examples of good practices and resources to enable teachers, trainers or anyone who is interested in providing learning activities outside school normal school hours.
